Ancient Olympic Games come to a sudden end when the Roman emperor 'Theodosius' banned these games in the year 394 A.D. The glory of these games vanished with time as ruins are still present in Olympiad. The Olympic motto is "Cities, Altius, Fortius" which means to perform for the fastest, highest, and strongest competition. This motto was pronounced by Baron Pierre De Coubertin at Paris Olympics in 1900. Special Olympic International was started by Eunice Kennedy Shriver (sister of former President of the United State of America, John F. Kennedy). The idea was born out of Shriver's experience of witnessing the social exclusion of people with intellectual disabilities who were placed in custodial institutions as a routine. Ludwig Guttmann Shriver believed that with equal opportunities and experiences as everyone else, people with intellectual disabilities could accomplish far more than ever thought possible. She was convinced that children with intellectual disabilities could be witnessed the first International Special Olympic Games in Chicago in July 1968. It gives training and coaching to build the interest in sports, skill perfection, social interaction, communication skills, and talent and leadership abilities in intellectual disabled persons.
